Iconic Experiences

Family Adventure & Flying Friends

Start your day off with an exciting activity at WildPlay Zipline to the Falls (ages 7+) or WildPlay Whirlpool Adventure Course (ages 5+) to enjoy a thrilling adventure and incredible views. If you're feeling extra daring, ride the rapids of the Niagara River with Whirlpool Jet Boat Tours (wet and dry boats available). Get up close with nature and make new flying friends at the Bird Kingdom or Butterfly Conservatory.

Safari Niagara

Get outside for a day of exploring, learning about animals and spending quality family time together at Safari Niagara, a 150-acre nature park with lions, giraffes, hippos, monkeys and more. Extra activities include a ropes course, paddle boats, carousel and giant splash pad.

History & Culture

Experience the history of Niagara Falls; visit historic sites such as Old Fort Erie, Fort George, Laura Secord Homestead, McFarland House and Brock's Monument. To learn the history of the Welland Canal – and maybe see a ship passing through the lock – head over to the St Catharines Museum and Welland Canals Centre.

Did you know that Niagara Parks has 56 kilometres of parkland from Fort Erie to Niagara-on-the-Lake? Explore by foot or rent bikes and ebikes. Visit the Floral Showhouse, Queen Victoria Park, Oakes Garden Theatre, Niagara Glen and Nature Centre, White Water Walk, Botanical Gardens, Floral Clock and Dufferin Islands.
